

STANFORD UNIVERSITY COVID EXPOSURE GUIDELINES

(Faculty, Staff, Postdocs)

EXPOSURE TYPE	QUARANTINE/ISOLATION	POST-EXPOSURE TESTING *Test sooner with rapid test if develop symptoms	FACE COVERING
HOUSEHOLD EXPOSURE Share a room with the COVID+ individual, including a child in your house or a significant other	Need to quarantine Report exposure in HealthCheck. Medical response team will assess symptoms and nature of exposure for onsite access.	COVID test every few days until 5 days after your last infectious contact (Color/PCR/ Rapid Antigen)	
HIGH-INTENSITY EXPOSURE Shared a prolonged car ride or similar, enclosed, unventilated, and unmasked exposure with an infectious person	Need to quarantine Report exposure in HealthCheck. Medical response team will assess symptoms and nature of exposure for onsite access.	day 4 Color/PCR (or day 5 rapid antigen test) Need negative test to return same day	Wear a well-fitting, high- quality face covering for 10 days after your last exposure (i.e. KN95)
OTHER CLOSE CONTACT EXPOSURE Close contact, within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more, not meeting the conditions of high- intensity or household exposure	No quarantine required	day 4 Color/PCR (or day 5 rapid antigen test)
